## THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL (COLDHILL LANE) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that on 23 January 2024 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to impose a 40mph speed limit on Coldhill Lane, Saxton, from 130m west of Copley Lane to a point 750m east along Coldhill Lane, for an experimental period of eighteen months.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 12 February 2024, together with a map showing the road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Northallerton and at Selby Library, 52 Micklegate, Selby YO8 4EQ during normal office hours from 1 August 2024 until 11 August 2025 and also viewed online at <a href="https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map">https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map</a> and <a href="https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map">https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/road

The Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is the later), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Order must state the grounds for their objection, in writing, addressed to Area 7 Selby Office Canal Road Selby North Yorkshire YO8 OAG or via email to area7.selby@northyorks.gov.uk by 11 August 2024.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the above Experimental Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may, within six weeks of 23 January 2024 make application to the High Court for that purpose.
