

Proposed Installation of Zebra Crossing - A6108 Richmond Road, Leyburn

The 'Safer Roads Fund' was established by the Department for Transport to provide road safety improvements on the 50 highest risk local A Roads in England. North Yorkshire Council has been allocated funding for works at the following locations:

- A167 Topcliffe to Busby Stoop
- A6108 from Ripon to Scotch Corner
- A684 from Leeming Bar to Junction 37 of the M6
- A682 Barrowford to A65 at Long Preston

The A6108 bid comprised of a number of works proposals including:

- An off-road route for non-motorised users from Bellerby to Leyburn.
- Improved Traffic Signal equipment in Richmond along with new signals in Richmond.
- New Lighting and an improved Zebra Crossing in Leyburn.
- Junction redesign work at Sharrow Lane roundabout, Ripon.
- Various signing, lining, traffic calming, parking and priority system works along the route.

This proposal relates to the proposed introduction of a Zebra Crossing on the A6108 Richmond Road in Leyburn. The accompanying plan (titled 'A6108 Richmond Road Pedestrian Improvements') shows the details of the proposed scheme which owing to its proximity to the local Secondary School is anticipated to be of benefit to pedestrians in the area.
