## PROPOSED INTRODUCTION OF WAITING RESTRICTION CRABMILL LANE, EASINGWOLD

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order, on one or more of the grounds contained in Section I of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- (i) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- (ii) For improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
- (iii) For facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic.

The proposal seeks to introduce a 'No Waiting at any time' restriction on Crabmill Lane, Easingwold.

The proposal seeks to improve accessibility for businesses within the area and therefore aid local economy.
