

Adoption Statement

In accordance with the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that Harrogate Borough Council adopted the Renewable and Low Carbon Energy Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 14 January 2015.

The SPD considers each renewable energy technology and sets out the pros, cons and issues related with it. It provides guidance on how to minimise any potential harmful effects, and whether planning permission is required or not. It also includes local case studies of technologies that have already been installed and the lessons that have been learnt from them.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the SPD, may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision, and that any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
