(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (STOKESLEY ROAD, HUTTON RUDBY) ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified below:-

1	Stokesley Road, Hutton Rudby	26 metres east from the centre line of Rudby Lea for a distance of 146 metres in an easterly direction.
