**PUBLIC FOOTPATH 10.86/12, HALL GARTH, KNAYTON DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

The above Order, made on 18/06/2024, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the Public Footpath described below.

Public Footpath 10.86/12 between SE 4326 8764 and SE 4329 8763 will be diverted onto a new route from SE 4326 8764, to SE 4329 8763, via SE 4327 8763.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Northallerton Library, North Yorkshire until 26/07/2024. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The North Yorkshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the Public Footpath described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The District Of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mrs. H. Appleton, Hall Garth, Knayton, Thirsk, YO7 4AS has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Knayton With Brawith Parish Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Hall Garth, Knayton With Brawith and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up from the date of confirmation of this Order and thereupon The District Of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
2. There shall from the date of confirmation of this Order be a Public Footpath over the land situated at Hall Garth, Knayton With Brawith shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and thereupon The District Of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map shall be modified by adding that Public Footpath to it.
3. The District Of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
