NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road at Barton specified below:-

2	Church Lane, Barton	From its junction with Silver Street north westwards to a point 49 metres north west of its junction with the centre line of Church Meadows (measured along the eastern kerb line)
3	Marygate, Barton	From its junction with Silver Street south eastwards to a point 10 metres south east of its junction with the southernmost side of Wells Lane (measured along the eastern kerb line)
4	The Porch, Barton	In its entirety
5	Wells Lane, Barton	In its entirety
6	Kettle End, Barton	In its entirety
7	East View, Barton	In its entirety
