(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) **(NOSTERFIELD) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 5th July 2024 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

Roads	Lengths
Nosterfield to West Tanfield Road including the eastern access road past the Green	From the junction with the B6267 South to a point 88 metres South of the centre line of the junction with the access road to Kiln Farm
The Croft	For its entire length
B6267	From a point 53 metres East of the centre point of the junction with Meadow Lane for a distance of 488 metres West to a point 237 metres West of the centre point of the junction with the U1530

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 15th July 2024, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Masham Community Library, c/o Masham Community Office, Little Market Place, Masham, North Yorkshire HG4 4DY during normal office hours from 12th July 2024 until 16th August 2024 and also viewed online at <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map> or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 5th July 2024 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
