

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (A61 RIPON ROAD) (RIPON TO RIPLEY) ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified below:-

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	A61 Ripon Road	80 metres from the highway boundary to the access road to Hood Hole in a southerly direction for a distance of 2336 metres to a point 130 metres north of the highway boundary of the C378 to Burton Leonard.
2.	A61 Ripon Road	340 metres south of the southern highway boundary of the C375 at Wormald Green in a southerly then westerly direction for a distance of 5402 metres to the northerly highway boundary of the B6165 / Main Street (U2796) Ripley Roundabout.
