## (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIOUS ROADS, GILLING EAST) ORDER 2024

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

Item	Road	Length
1.	B1363, Station Road	From its junction with Pottergate in a generally Northerly direction for 351 metres.
2.	B1363, Main Street	Its entire length.
3.	B1363, Burnt Gill	From its junction with Main Street in a Southeasterly direction for 42 metres.
4.	U636, Pottergate	Its entire length.
5.	U636, Park Farm Road	From its junction with Pottergate in a Westerly direction for 14 metres.
6.	U122, Cawton Road	Its entire length.
7.	U122, Gilling East to Cawton	From its junction with Cawton Road in an Easterly direction for 29 metres.
8.	U637, Church Lane	Its entire length.
