Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

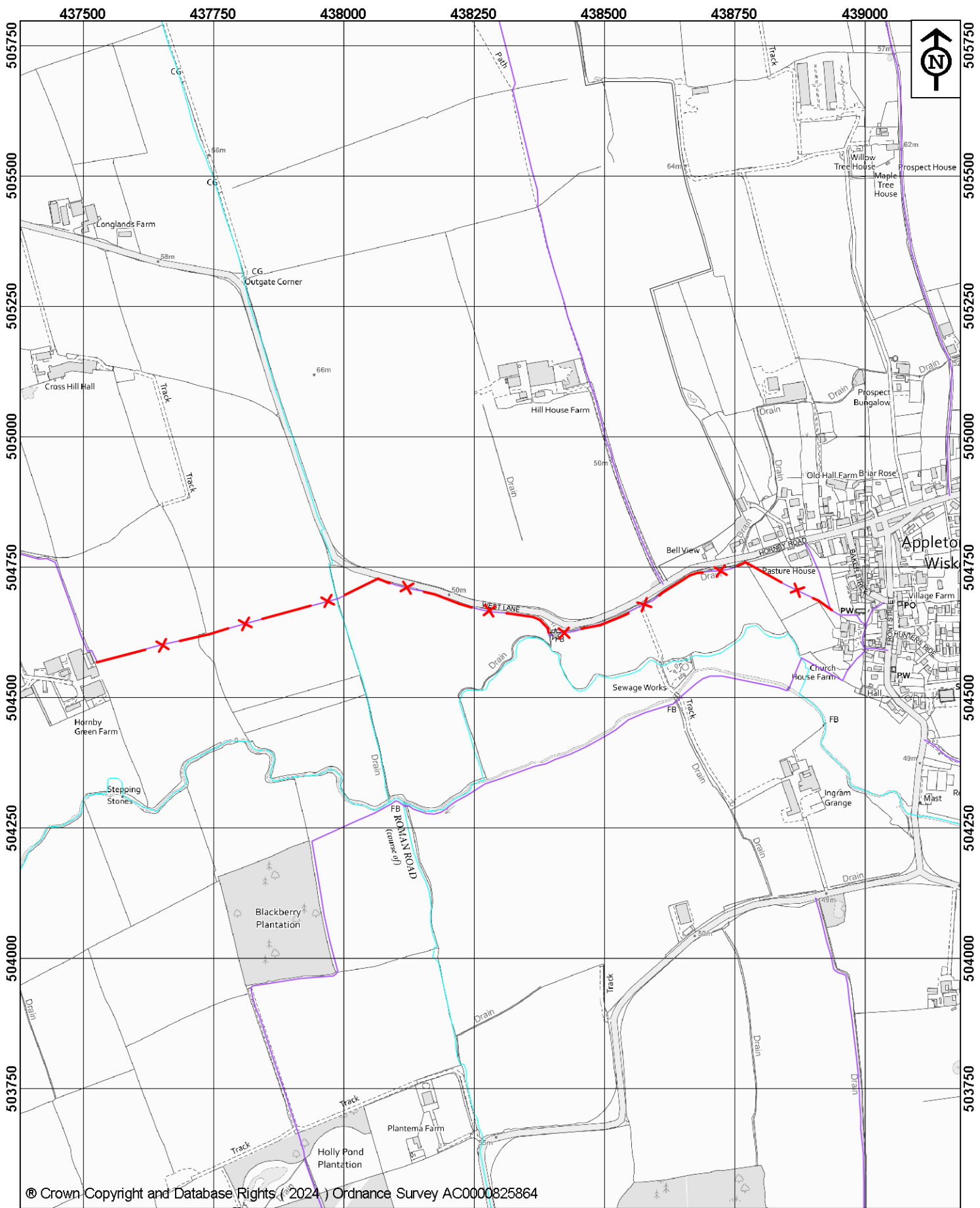
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpaths 10.8/3/1 in the Parish of Appleton Wiske and 10.66/1/1 in the Parish of Hornby between grid references NZ38930467 and NZ37520456 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025 and 24<sup>th</sup> January 2025 due to an unsafe bridge. This Order follows a closure under Emergency Notice No 270 which commenced on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
