ORDER 2024 NO 351
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council intends to make this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 35.41/5/1 and 35.41/1/1 in the Parish of Kellington and 35.7/3/1 in the Parish of Beal, between grid reference SE54532579 and SE55062516 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 14th October 2024 and 13th April 2025 due to flood embankment repair works.

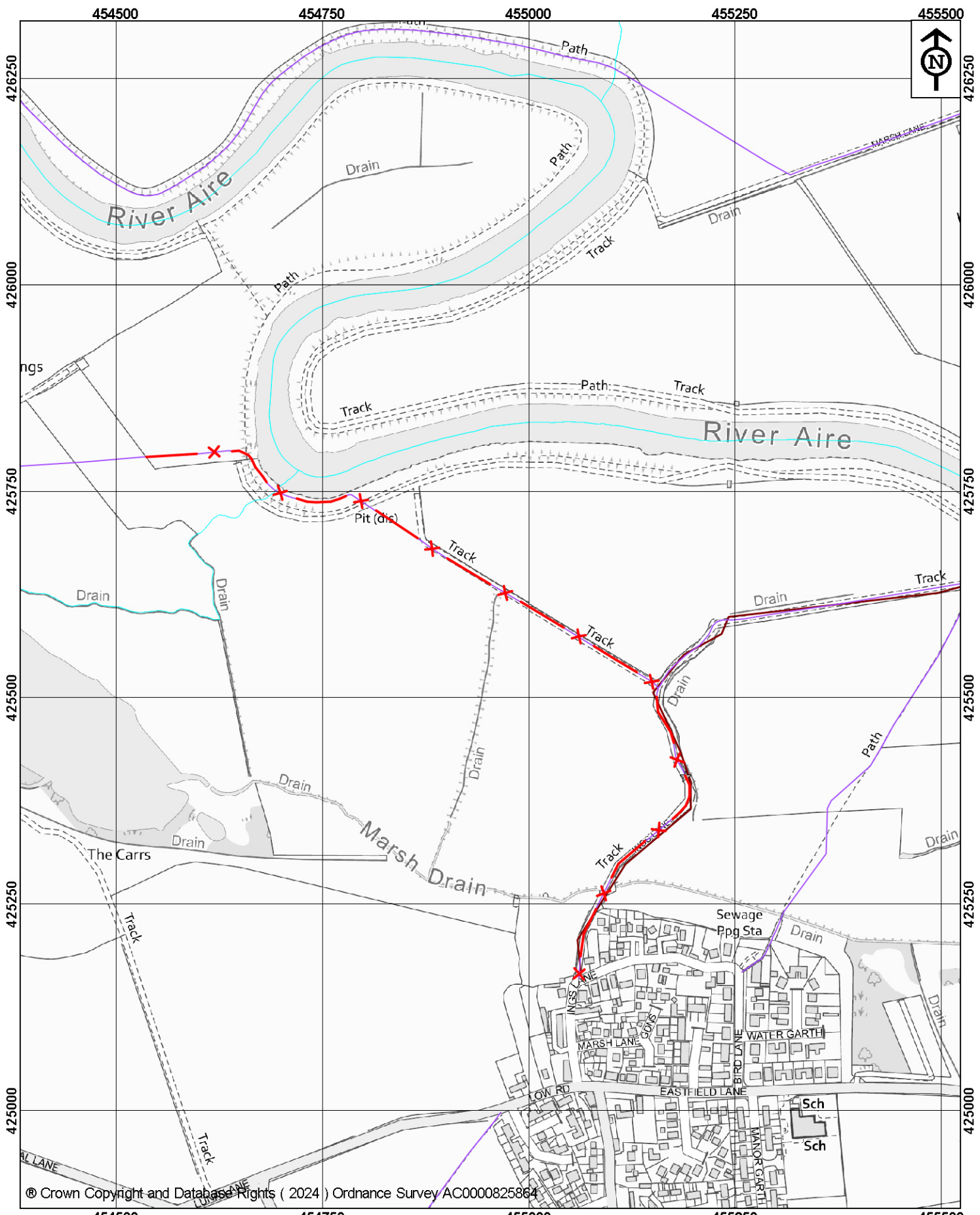
The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
