Scarborough Road	From the centre line of its junction with Church Street, for a distance of 178.8 metres.
High Street	From the centre line of its junction with Church Street, for a distance of 338.0 metres.
Rectory Close	From the centre line of its junction with High Street, for a distance of 56.4 metres.

White Gate	From the centre line of its junction with A64, Southwards for a distance of 204 metres.
