PROPOSED extension of 30 mph SPEED LIMIT: Turnham Lane, Cliffe

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order on one or more of the grounds contained in Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- 1. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising,
- 2. for improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

The proposal seeks to achieve the following:

Extension of 30mph speed limit

- The extension of the 30mph speed limit for 230m West of the current location is being proposed as the existing 60mph speed limit is inappropriate with regards to newly developed holiday park.
