(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (VARIOUS ROADS, GILLING EAST) ORDER 2024

The North Yorkshire Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby order as follows:-


- 1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any Order or regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- This Order shall come into operation on 23rd September 2024 and may be cited as "The North Yorkshire Council (30 mph Speed Limit) (Various Roads, Gilling East) Order 2024".

4.	U636, Pottergate	Its entire length.
5.	U636, Park Farm Road	From its junction with Pottergate in a Westerly direction for 14 metres.
6.	U122, Cawton Road	Its entire length.
7.	U122, Gilling East to Cawton	From its junction with Cawton Road in an Easterly direction for 29 metres.
8.	U637, Church Lane	Its entire length.
