(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (Cundall) **ORDER 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 8th October 2024 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

SCHEDULE 1

40 MPH SPEED LIMIT

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Item</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Road</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Length</u>
1.	Cundall to Poplar Hill, Cundall	A point from the centreline of Hall Lane for a distance of 851.4m in a north westerly direction.
2.	Cundall to Thornton Bridge, Cundall	A point from the centreline of Hall Lane for a distance of 298m in a south easterly direction.
3.	Cundall to Bat Bridge, Cundall	A point from its junction with Cundall to Poplar Hill for a distance of 184.4m in a south westerly.
4.	Hall Lane, Cundall	Along its entire length
5.	Church Lane, Cundall	Along its entire length
