TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257 PUBLIC FOOTPATH 05.5/92 WATERSCALE GREYSTONEGILL LANE BENTHAM DIVERSION ORDER 2024

The above Order was made on 29 October 2024 under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the following footpath:-

The existing Footpath number 05.5/92 which commences at Grid Reference 36932 46832 (Point A) and proceeds in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 254 metres across a field and between buildings, to Grid Reference 36950 46846 (Point B) its junction with Footpath 05.5/45: on a grass / natural and then a concrete surface.

The newly diverted Footpath number 05.5/92 will commence near the corner of a field at Grid Reference 36932 46832 (Point A), proceeding in a generally north-northeasterly direction on grass for 170 metres approximately, passing through a Gate at Grid Reference 36937 46848 (Point C) continuing northwards for 5 metres to Grid Reference 36938 46848 its junction with Footpath 05.5/45 (Point D); with a width of 2 metres.

The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 3 of the Schedule:

Install at Point C a one-way opening Pedestrian Gate to BS 5709: 2018, with minimum internal width 1.2 metres and maximum internal width 3.7 metres.
