## PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING) (AMENDMENT NO 35) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE** is hereby given that on 8 November 2024 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend "North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Richmondshire) Consolidation Order 2013" by introducing the restrictions specified in the table below:-

## TABLE PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING

Location	Road	Side	Length	Nature of Restriction
Richmond	Frenchgate	West	From its junction with the A6136 Dundas Street for a distance of 7 metres in a northerly direction	No Waiting At Any Time
Richmond	Church Wynd	Both	From its junction with the back of the footway on the east side of Frenchgate for its entire length	No Waiting At Any Time

With regard to 'North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Richmondshire) Consolidation Order 2013' reference to the following shall be revoked:

Richmond / Frenchgate / West / From its junction with the A6136 Dundas Street / For a distance of 19 metres in a northerly direction / No waiting at any time.

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 8 November 2024 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
