

## Post-hearing Further Information Matter 2 – Vision, Objectives and General Principles

Further to discussions at the hearing sessions, the Council has been asked to provide further information regarding the proposed boundary amendment, specifically the revised distance to the Kirk Hammerton Conservation Area, as well as the presence of a historic land fill site.

## **Distance to Kirk Hammerton Conservation Area**

Map one shows the proposed revised boundary, as well as the boundary of the Kirk Hammerton Conservation Area. It shows the distance from the settlement boundary and the Kirk Hammerton Conservation Area boundary changes from approx. 440m to 360m along Gilsthwaite Lane as a result of the proposed boundary amendment.

## Prescence of a Historic Landfill Site

Map two shows the locations of historic landfill sites in the area. It shows that there is a historic landfill site to the east of the revised proposed boundary, in the area proposed for the Strategic Green Gap. The site was active between 1989 and 1990 and is understood to have been used to deposit rubble from road construction. It is not considered to be an issue that would impact upon the deliverability of Maltkiln.
