**NOTICE OF MAKING OF A PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

**PUBLIC FOOTPATHS 10.72.15 & 10.171/7, GLEBE HOUSE, WHORLTON AND
HUTTON RUDBY DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

The above Order, made on 21/01/2025, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the Public Footpaths described below.

Public Footpath 10.171/7 between NZ 4432 0275 and NZ 4462 0292 will be diverted onto a new route from NZ 4435 0271 to NZ 4465 0287 via NZ 4436 0271 and NZ 4452 0278. Public Footpath 10.72/15 between NZ 4462 0292 and NZ 4483 0300 will be diverted onto a new route from NZ 4465 0287 to NZ 4483 0300.

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours at Stokesley Library, North Yorkshire until 28/02/2025. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to Steve Metcalfe, Definitive Map Team, North Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Northallerton, North Yorkshire DL7 8AD or email steve.metcalfe@northyorks.gov.uk not later than 28 February 2025. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The North Yorkshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

**PUBLIC FOOTPATHS 10.72/15 & 10.171/7, GLEBE HOUSE, WHORLTON AND HUTTON
RUDBY DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the Public Footpaths described in Paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the Public Footpaths should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The District Of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Whorlton And Hutton Rudby Parish Councils have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Glebe House, Whorlton and Hutton Rudby and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new section of path, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be Public Footpaths over the land situated at Glebe House, Whorlton And Hutton Rudby described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: Pedestrian Gates to BS5709:2018 to be provided at Points E and F as shown on the Order plan and the bridge which is currently located at Point B to be moved to Point G. A well-defined, minimum 2 metres wide, path to be provided for the entire length of the new route (Points D-E-F-G-C, as shown on the Order Plan).
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
5. The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.

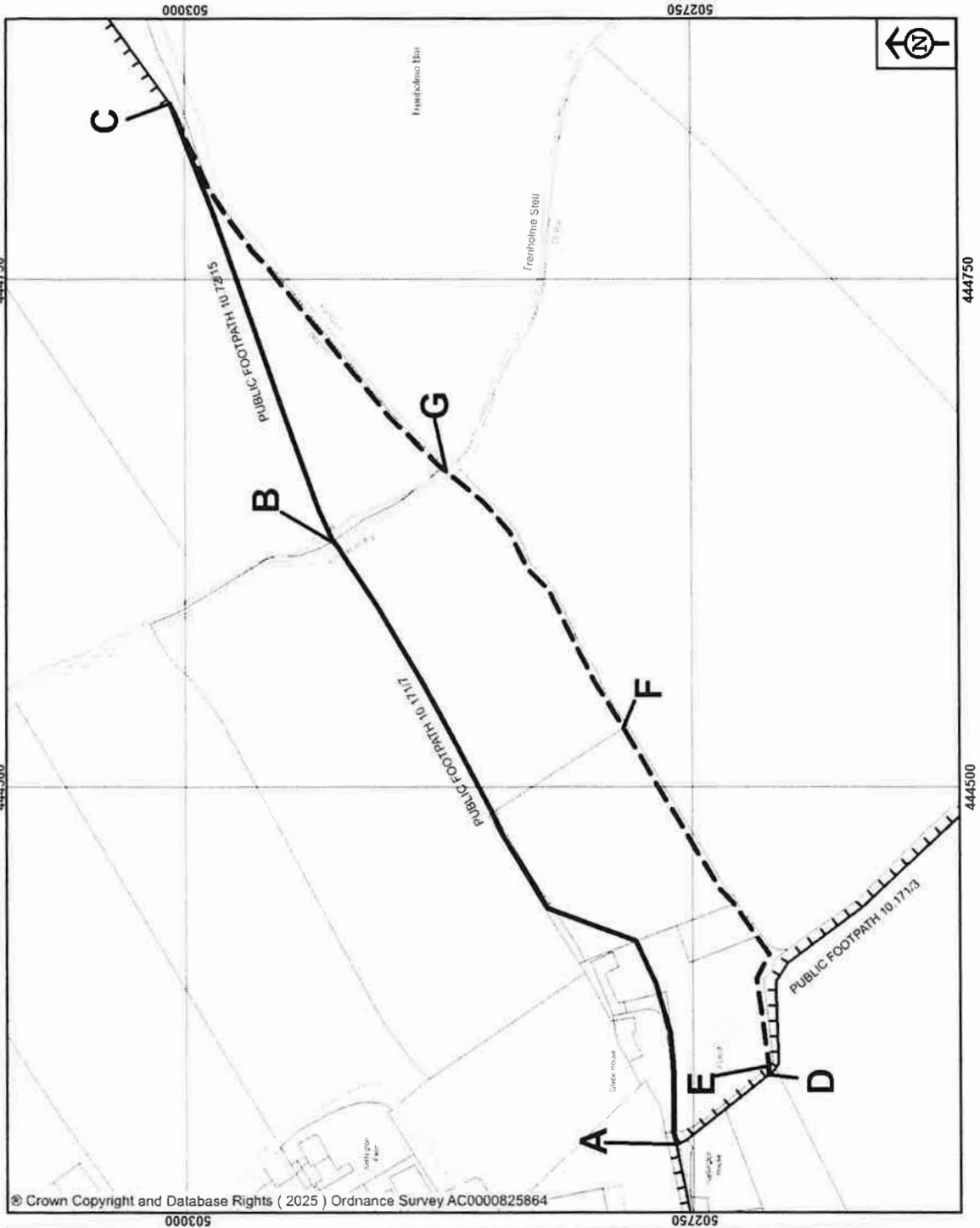
