(STATION BRIDGE, HARROGATE)
ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 10 January 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along any length of road specified in column 2 of the following Schedule 1 in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in column 3 of that Schedule 1:-

SCHEDULE 1
PRESCRIBED ROUTE

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3
Item	Road and Junction	Direction in which traffic must flow from junction
1.	Station Bridge, Harrogate, in a southwest bound direction at its junction of Station Parade, Harrogate.	Left turn into Station Parade, Harrogate.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 24 January 2025, together with a map showing the road affected may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Harrogate Library, Victoria Avenue, Harrogate HG1 1EG during normal office hours from 23 January 2025 until 21 February 2025 and also viewed online at <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map> or <https://www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders>.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 10 January 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
