PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROVISION OF PARKING)
(NEW LANE, SELBY)
(AMENDMENT NO 55) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on 03 01 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and under the Traffic Management Act 2004, the effect of which is to amend “North Yorkshire County Council (Prohibition of Waiting and Loading and Provision of Parking) (District of Selby) Consolidation Order 2013” by introducing the restrictions specified in the Schedule below:-

Selby	New Lane	West	From its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	A point 37 metres south of its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	No Loading At Any Time
Selby	New Lane	East	From its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	A point 37 metres south of its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	No Loading At Any Time
Selby	New Lane	West	From a point 66 metres south of its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	A point 83 metres south of its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	No Waiting between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Saturday inclusive
Selby	New Lane	West	From point 83 metres south of its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	A point 94 metres south of its junction with the A19 Gowthorpe	Area of carriageway reserved for taxis

If you wish to question the validity of the above Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 03 01 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
