C1, STOKESLEY TO TAME BRIDGE, STOKESLEY

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council as the Highway Authority for North Yorkshire considers that it is expedient to make the Traffic Regulation Order, on one or more of the grounds contained in Section I of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as indicated below:

- (i) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- (ii) For preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic in a manner which is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road.
- (iii) For improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.

The extension to the 30mph zone is considered necessary due to the development that is to be constructed on the South side of the C1, Stokesley.

The proposal is as illustrated on the plan marked A2.1086
