ORDER 2025 NO 35

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpath 35.5/5/1 in the Parish of Barlby with Osgodby, between grid reference SE63933355 and SE63983370 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 24<sup>th</sup> February 2025 and 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2025 due to Building Works that have a potential danger to the public.

The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
