ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(2a) (AS AMENDED)

North Yorkshire Council hereby gives notice that from 17th March 2025 until 6th April 2025 inclusive, no pedestrian, cyclist or horse riders shall proceed along Public Bridleways 35.44/5/1, 35.69/1/1 & 39.63/9/3 in the Parishes of Lead, Towton & Sutton With Hazlewood, between grid references SE47294113 and SE48363964, due to an unsafe bridge. This Emergency closure will be followed by a six month closure until 16th September 2025.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate. Please note the alternative route is for pedestrians only.

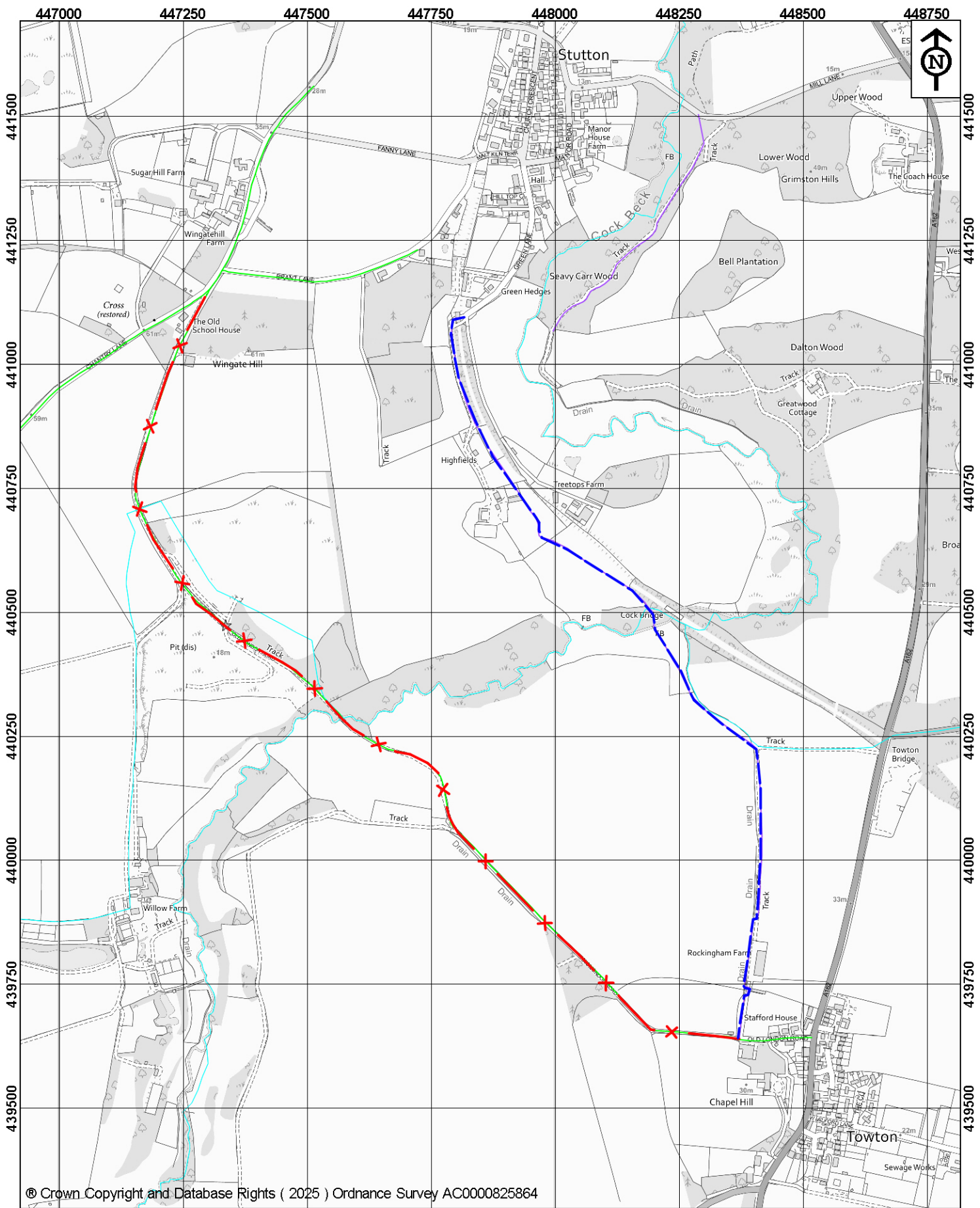
Access for pedestrians to premises will be maintained at all times.
