(C1, STOKESLEY TO TAME BRIDGE, STOKESLEY)
ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on 07 March 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

Road	Length
C1, Stokesley to Tame Bridge	A distance 100m West from the centre of the roundabout leading to Apple Tree Road for a distance of 100m in a Westerly direction.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 17 March 2025, may be examined at County Hall, Northallerton and at Stokesley Globe Community Library, Town Close, North Road, Stokesley TS9 5DH during normal office hours from 14 March 2025 until 18 April 2025 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 07 March 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
