The above Order, made on 04/03/2025, under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will divert the Public Footpaths described below.

Public Footpath 10.164/1 between SE 3927 9965 and SE 3939 9969, via SE 3931 9967 will be diverted onto a new route between SE 3927 9965 and SE 3939 9969 via SE 3929 9964 and SE 3931 9962. Public Footpath 10.164/2 between SE 3937 9973 and SE 3931 9967 will be diverted onto a new route from SE 3937 9973 to SE 3939 9969.

Please state the grounds on which they are made.

Please note that objections/representations cannot be treated as confidential and may come into the public domain. Copies of any objections or representations received may be disclosed to interested parties, including the Planning Inspectorate where the case is referred to it for determination.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The North Yorkshire Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

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This Order is made by The North Yorkshire Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the public it is expedient that the line of the Public Footpaths should be diverted.

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the Authority that The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Welbury Parish Council have been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Acta

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public rights of way over the land situated at Wray House, Welbury and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which the Authority certifies, in accordance with Section 119(3)(b) of the 1980 Act, that work to the new sections of path, as described in Part 2 of the Schedule, has been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the Authority. Under no circumstances shall such certification be given before the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall from the date of the above mentioned certification be Public Footpaths over the land situated at Wray House, Welbury described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
- 3. The following works shall be carried out by the applicant in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule: Pedestrian gates to BS5709:2018 to be installed at Points E and F on the attached plan.
- 4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.
- 5. The District of Hambleton (outside The North York Moors National Park) Definitive Statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
