

THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (MENWITH HILL ROAD AND B6451, MENWITH HILL) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that The North Yorkshire Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which will be to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour on any length of road specified below:-

<u>Column 1 Item</u>	<u>Column 2 Road</u>	<u>Column 3 Length</u>
1.	Darley Carr (B6451/2/40)	From a point 110 metres North of the centreline of the Menwith Hill Road junction with the B6451, to a point 150 metres South of the Steeplebush Gate of RAF Menwith Hill on Menwith Hill Road towards Dangerous Corner.
2.	Menwith Hill Road (C252/1/40)	In its entirety from its junction with the B6451 to its junction with Stumps Lane (U3287/2/30).

A copy of the draft Order, together with a map showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Northallerton and at Harrogate Library, Victoria Avenue, Harrogate HG1 1EG during normal office hours from 20th March 2025 until 10th April 2025 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.
