THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL (RICCALL LANE, KELFIELD) (40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2025

NOTICE is hereby given that on 21 March 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to impose a 40 mph Speed Limit on Riccall Lane, Kelfield from the existing 30 mph signs in an easterly direction for 356m, for an experimental period of eighteen months.

A copy of the Order, which comes into operation on 31 March 2025, together with a map showing the road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at County Hall, Northallerton and at Barlby Library and Community Hub, Howden Road, Barlby, Selby YO8 5JE during normal office hours from 27 March 2025 until 30 September 2025 and also viewed online at www.northyorks.gov.uk/roadworks-map or www.northyorks.gov.uk/traffic-regulation-orders.

The Council will be considering, in due course, whether the provisions of the Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months from the coming into force of the Order, or if the Order is subsequently varied or modified, from the coming into operation of that variation or modification (whichever is the later), any person may object to the making of an Order for the purposes of such indefinite continuation.

Any person wishing to object to the indefinite continuation of the Order must state the grounds for their objection, in writing, addressed to Area 7 Selby Highways Office, Canal Road, Selby, North Yorkshire YO8 0AG or by email to Area7.Selby@northyorks.gov.uk or via the website link above by 30 September 2025.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the above Experimental Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, they may, within six weeks of 21 March 2025 make application to the High Court for that purpose.
