

# THE NORTH YORKSHIRE COUNCIL

## **(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) (A61 RIPON ROAD) (RIPON TO RIPLEY)** **ORDER 2025**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 7 March 2025 The North Yorkshire Council made an Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from travelling at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour on any length of road specified below.

1.	A61 Ripon Road	80 metres from the highway boundary to the access road to Hood Hole in a southerly direction for a distance of 2336 metres to a point 130 metres north of the highway boundary of the C378 to Burton Leonard.
2.	A61 Ripon Road	340 metres south of the southern highway boundary of the C375 at Wormald Green in a southerly then westerly direction for a distance of 5402 metres to the northerly highway boundary of the B6165 / Main Street (U2796) Ripley Roundabout.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks of 7 March 2025 make application to the High Court for the purpose.
