Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

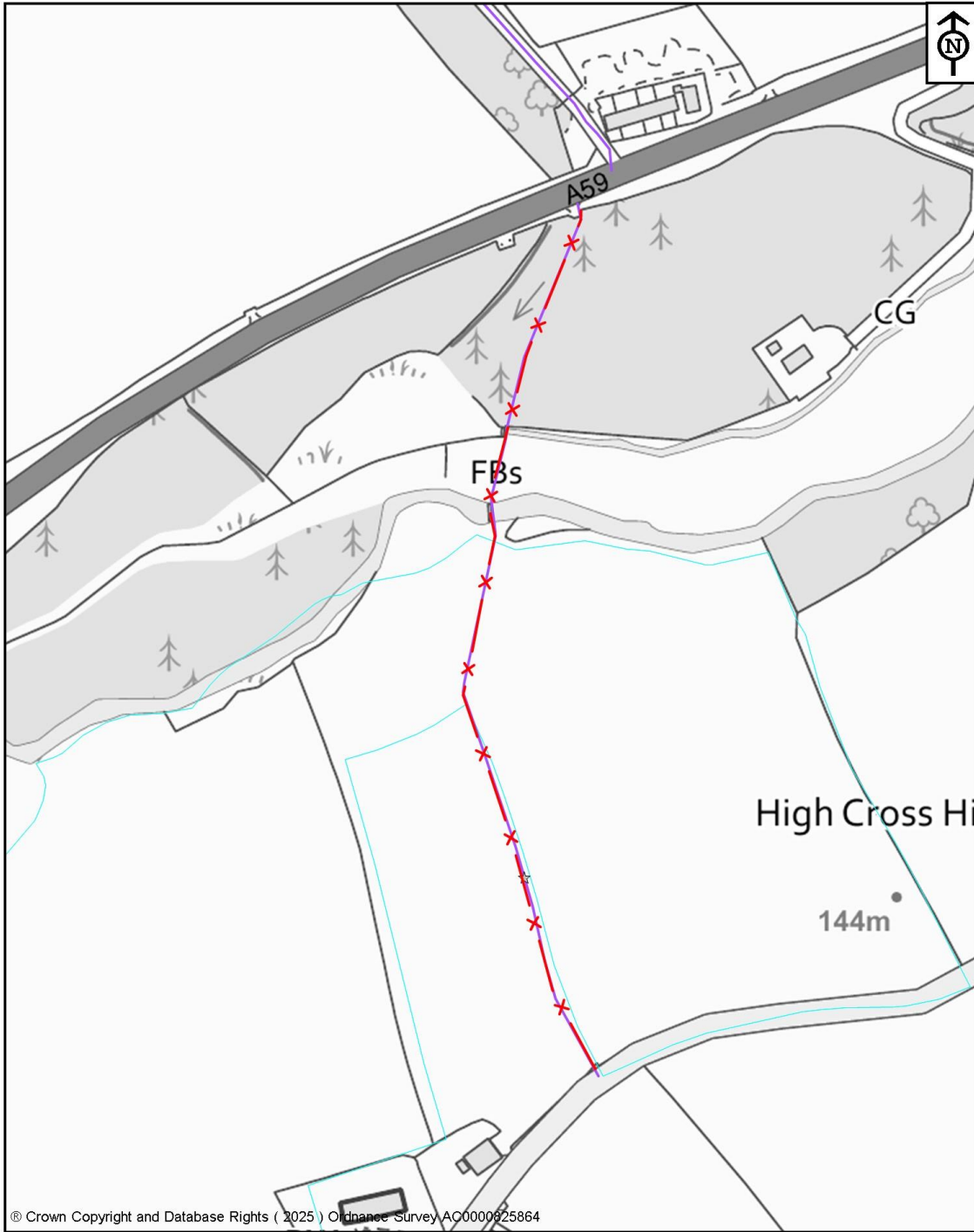
North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using Public Footpath, 05.8/9/1 & 05.16/14/1 & 05.8/8/1 in the Parish of Broughton, between grid reference SD93515042 and SD93515085 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 10th February 2025 and 09th August 2025 due to Bridge in need of repair. This Order follows Emergency Notice No 43.


The closure period will be indicated by the placing of traffic signs and a local alternative route will be signed on site where appropriate.
