ORDER 2025 NO 57  
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

North Yorkshire Council has made this Order to prohibit any pedestrian from using the Public Footpaths 35.18/4/1, 35.18/5/1 & 35.18/6/1 in the Parish of Carlton, between grid reference SE63432458, SE64402432 and SE64112468, SE64372434 and SE64162555, SE64502459 for a temporary period of up to six months (subject to access to premises) between 12<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 the routes will only be closed for a 5-week period within a 6 month period due to works being carried out on the overhead lines.

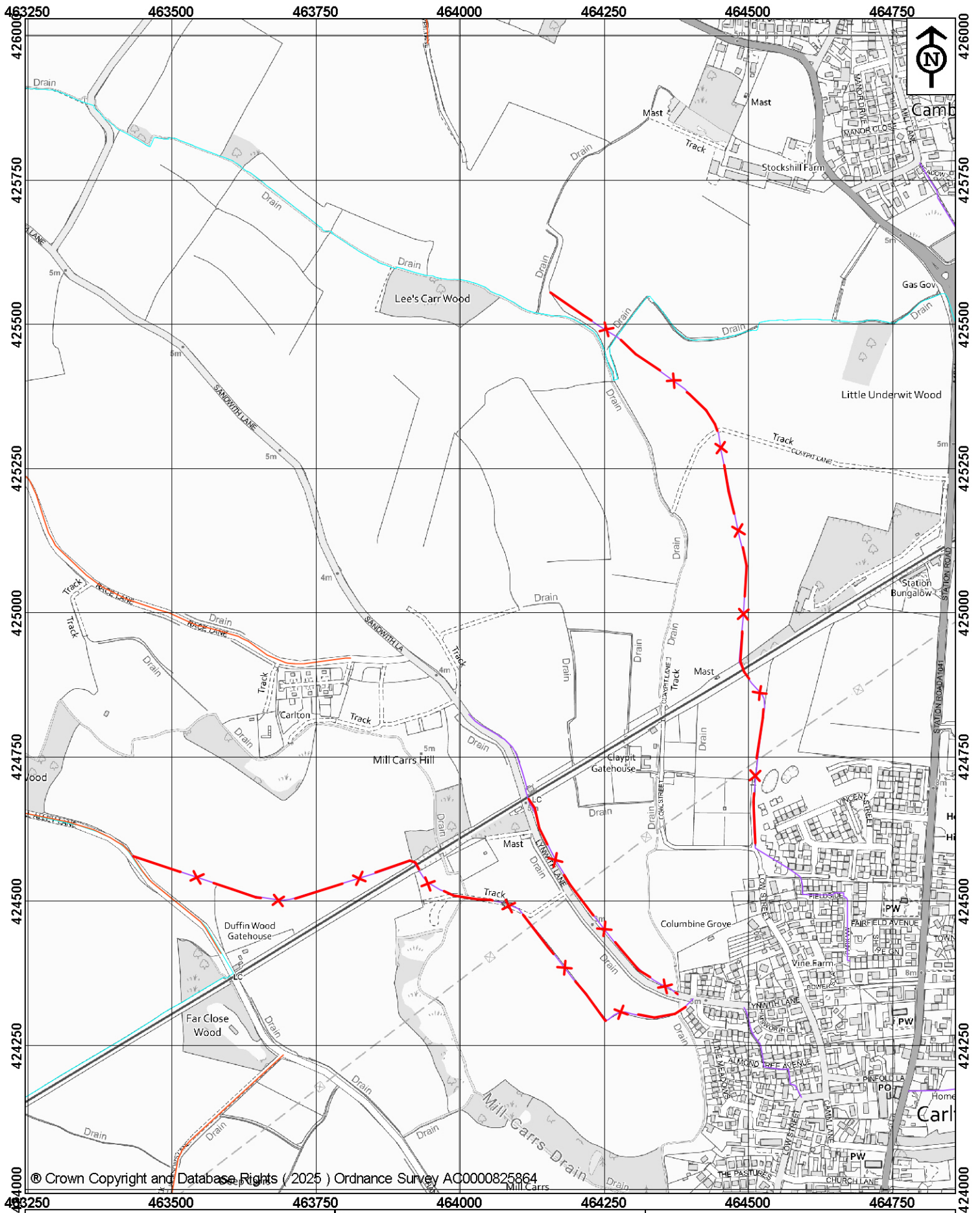
The closure period will apply as indicated by the placing of traffic signs.
