The suggestions from BRAYTON/001 to BRAYTON/018 would allow for 4591 new homes in a village of 2000 at the moment, I can't even give the % increase that would allow.

200 new homes is a 10% increase and that is more than enough.

The infrastructure would not allow for anything like the proposed homes or even 200 new homes.

The junior school is at maximum capacity where some siblings are being sent to other schools as there is not enough room.

The speeding in Brayton is legendary now, with more cars it would be worse.

We struggle to get an appointment at the Drs surgery now.

With even 200 more homes, 2-4 to a house?

BUT the main complaint is that it would leave us with no strategic gap.

We would all blend into Selby and Thorpe Willoughby.

That is not what a village is about.

We need the gap around the village and around the Barff.

We need to protect the Barff and its wildlife, walks and views.

It's special to our area and we need to protect it not build up to it.

I understand the need for new housing but 4591 in Brayton, really?

Even 200 is too much, as said, it's 10%.

The education, highways and Drs are NOT set up for any more additions and would struggle with an additional 100 houses.
