Additional Comments - Please provide any additional comments you may wish to make.

Having encounted problems accessing PLAN selby and the associated documents and forms, I have been unable to comment on the specific topic areas covered, but I wish to make the following observations!

- 1. Issues of transport and infrastructure need to be properly researched and addressed before any development is allowed to preceed. For example, the council considers that North Duffield, a Designated Service Village, has good transport links. It does not. Public transport to Selby is totally inadequate, and the York bus service is unreliable and does not coter for those who need to start work oarly or finish late, leaving people with no option but to use private cars. This, in turn, leads to increased traffic and parking problems in the village. The primary school, already extended several times, carriet accommodate further pufels, and there have been a number of problems with Eswage and drainage.
- 2. When assessing housing requirements, consideration needs to be given to the age of the population in different areas. For example, in villages where there is an ageing population, there is a need for dueltased accommodation, internent apartinants and bungalows. Such previous would enable the alderly to downsize whilst remaining in their own locality. This would free up a number of 3- and 4- bedroomed homes, thus reducing the need to build such preparties. In areas viliase these are employment opportunities and good public transport, there is a need for affordable rented apartments/studio flats for single people.
- 3. In view of the threat of climate change and the likely uncertainty of supplies, it would seem prudent to preserve agricultural land from any form of development - once lost, it cannot be redored.
