I would like to voice my objection to the proposed erection of 2028 houses on land adjacent to Kellington Lane in Eggborough.

The following are my reasons for objection:

- Housing on this land has already been rejected in an earlier planning application after much public outcry including demonstrations, public meetings and television interviews by our local councillor.
- The proposal would alter the whole character of the village, more than doubling it in size. It would no longer be a village.
- The proposed housing would also be taking place outside the traditional boundaries of the village (between the A19 and Kellington Lane and the A645 and M62)
- So many houses in Eggborough and proposed sites in Kellington and Whitley would mean the villages would all merge together.
- There will obviously be increased traffic on small local roads which are already busy.
 Junction 34 of the M62 which serves Eggborough is already very busy and there have been 2 serious accidents(1 fatal) there in the past few months and the increased heavy goods vehicles during construction and the new residents cars leaving the motorway will only serve to exacerbate this.
- The proposed land is also a green field site and I feel strongly that these should not be built on when there are vast numbers of brown field sites which should be developed first.
