In reviewing the document on Plan Selby, there is little or no reference to the former air base at Church Fenton. The only reference I can find states that the air base is still in MoD ownership, with operations scaled back. I understand that this is not correct, as it has been sold and is now in private hands, with a proportion of the airbase sold off for potential future housing. Has this been factored into the Selby Plan, if so this is quite a major site and omission from the Plan. If it is earmarked for development, what development is to be permitted, and what improvements to the local infrastructure will be linked to any development. More importantly, what restrictions will be put on development if infrastructure improvements are not made.

Please can the plan be updated to reflect the current ownership of the airbase and the plan that is in place to regulate the airbase's future use.
