


## Selby District Submission Draft Core Strategy

#### **The Tests of Soundness**

  - evidence of participation of the local community and others having a stake in the area
  - research/fact finding the choices made in the plan are backed up by facts
- the most appropriate strategy when considered against reasonable alternatives

#### 2 Effective

PPS12 states that Core Strategies should be effective. This means:

- Deliverable embracing:
  - Sound infrastructure delivery planning
  - Having no regulatory or national planning barriers to delivery
  - Delivery partners who are signed up to it
  - Coherence with the strategies of neighbouring authorities
- Flexible
- Able to be monitored
