Selby District Local Development Framework Proposed Changes to the Submission Draft Core Strategy

Thank you for your letter, dated 19 December 2011, consulting East Riding of Yorkshire Council on the Proposed Changes to the Submission Draft Core Strategy. We welcome opportunities to work on cross boundary issues, which will help to ensure the authorities prepare complementary Local Plans and fulfil the requirements of the duty to cooperate.

The Council notes that the Proposed Changes to the Core Strategy include amendments to the scale of housing in Selby District over the period to 2027 (Policy CP2). We note that additional evidence has been prepared to inform the level of housing, which has been increased from 440 dwellings per annum to 450 dwellings per annum, and a revised distribution. This approach is considered to be broadly consistent with the East Riding of Yorkshire Council's emerging Core Strategy
