Comments

Why do we want a multiplicity of windfarms? They produce relative little energy compared to other renewable/low energy sources, such as biomass. Therefore, the target should not be revised.

Question no. 26e

Comments

The turbine visible from the Selby bypass is 78 metres in height and is 2 kilometres away. The one at Hillam is only 67 metres tall and can be clearly seen from the A63 at a distance of 2 kilometres. Windfarms use turbine with a height of 125 metres or greater. I am aware of a proposed turbine, twice the height of that at Hillam, to be built 450 metres from homes. This is wholly unacceptable. Reasonable separation distances must be in place.
