Paragraph:

Comment: The Draft Infrastructure Plan and its Appendix 1 only addresses infrastructure needs in the three towns and eighteen DSVs although its conclusion suggests that it covers Core Strategy and Plan Selby. Identification and clarity of infrastructure needs that are outside these Towns and DSVs but needed for PLAN Selby development is omitted. To correct this the Infrastructure plan and its appendix 1 should include sections covering the infrastructure needed in aid of PLAN Selby that is outside of DSVs. These may be few in number but can be of critical importance such as a flood alleviation scheme at Ryther that is necessary to protect the vulnerable community before development in adjacent DSVs.

It is noted that mention is made of EA plans for separate major flood alleviation schemes at Cawood, Ulleskelf and Tadcaster costing tens of millions of pounds each but surprisingly Ryther flood alleviation has been ignored. EA and Ryther Parish Council have already developed a low cost flood alleviation pumping scheme for installation on EA land. Although a financial contribution has been provided from the EA Local Levy Fund, implementation cannot proceed without further funding. A Project Plan is available and quotations from contractors have been obtained. It is imperative that the scheme is implemented prior to any development in adjacent DSVs under PLAN Selby. Please include a project in the infrastructure Delivery Plan and Appendix 1.

Comment: In Paragraph 2.40 Land Drainage is correctly stated as contributing to flooding in several areas and that this is a flooding issue. The Authority that is responsible for dealing with this flooding issue should be stated and their proposals included.

Paragraph 2.41 is in error, the Land drainage flooding issue stated in paragraph 2.40 will not be dealt with by the normal planning process. It should be stated as a strategic issue that needs dealing with by infrastructure provision otherwise communities will suffer increased flooding. The document is in error in this regard. Flooding at Ryther is an example of this.
