Addendum to Core Strategy Background Paper No. 4

Previously Developed Land Target
January 2011

Introduction

A1 In July 2010, the Secretary of State amended the definition of Previously Developed Land (PDL) in PPS3 to exclude garden curtilage land. This addendum examines the impact of this decision on the target for PDL as proposed in Background Paper No.4.

Evidence

A2 Research of the Council's development monitoring records indicates the following:

Proportion of Completed Dwellings on Garden Curtilage Land	9.26%

A3 These figures indicate a relatively consistent proportion of approximately 10% of completions being on garden curtilage land over the past 10 years.

Impact on Previously Developed Land Target

A4 Because completions on garden curtilages are no longer classed as PDL and therefore not necessarily acceptable in principle, the PDL target established in Background Paper No.4 is reduced from 50% to 40%.
