Harrogate Borough Council resolved on 13th April 2011 to adopt with effect from 1st July 2011 that part of schedule 3 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 as amended by section 27 of the Policing and Crime Act 2009 relating to the licensing of sex entertainment venues.

Under these provisions no person shall use any premises, vehicle, vessel or stall in the Harrogate district as a sex entertainment venue except under and in accordance with the terms of a licence issued by the Council.

A sexual entertainment venue means any premises at which relevant entertainment is provided before a live audience for the financial gain of the organiser or the entertainer. Relevant entertainment means any live performance or any live display of nudity which is of such a nature that, ignoring financial gain, it must reasonably be assumed to be provided solely or principally for the purpose of sexually stimulating any member of the audience (whether by verbal or other means).

Those parts of Schedule 3 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 relating to sex cinemas or sex shops, have previously been adopted by resolution of Harrogate Borough Council and continue to have effect.
