Selby District Council is preparing a Core Strategy Development Plan Document. This document is part of the Local Development Framework (LDF) for Selby District which will replace the current Local Plan.



The Core Strategy will help establish a spatial vision to tackle the development pressures facing the District over the next 15 years or so and to ensure that future development is sustainable.

As a starting point the Council has produced an Issues and Options Report identifying the key issues, which it considers the Core Strategy should address to meet these challenges and to ensure that the needs of local communities are taken into account.
