In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Scarborough Borough Council formally adopted the Green Space Supplementary Planning Document on 3rd November 2014.

The Green Space Supplementary Planning Document sets out the Borough Council's approach towards securing developer contributions for the provision of new and improved green spaces alongside new housing development. As detailed within the 'Consultation Statement', prior to the adoption of the Green Space Supplementary Planning Document, a draft of the document was published for consultation for a period of 6 weeks. Comments received through the consultation process resulted in some minor modifications to the document, which were made pursuant to Section 23(1) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended).

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event, no later than three (3) months after the date on which the Green Space Supplementary Planning Document was adopted (i.e. no later than 3rd February 2015).
