Scarborough Borough Council formally adopted the Residential Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (the SPD) on the 25<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

The SPD builds upon adopted Scarborough Borough Local Plan (July 2017) policy to provide further clarity around the Council's design expectations for new residential developments, including extensions and alterations to existing homes. It draws from the National Design Guide and National Model Design Code to provide information and good practice guidance that can be used by decision-makers and applicants to help produce successful design outcomes.
