Richmondshire Local Plan 2018 - 2039

The Local Plan 2018 - 2039 will be the statutory development plan for the eastern part of Richmondshire which lies outside of the Yorkshire Dales National Park. It will set out the spatial strategy and policies for the use of land and buildings in this area and forms the basis for the assessment of all planning applications, together with national planning guidance.

The Local Plan 2018-2039 will be a single document and comprise of a review of the adopted Local Plan Core Strategy 2012-2028 and will provide site allocations, area strategy for Catterick Garrison, land use designations, revised Development Limits for settlements identified in the settlement hierarchy and detailed development policies. It will include an updated and revised Proposals Map.
