Scale and Distribution of Development 2004 - 2011

This note assesses the impact of windfall developments on housing supply in the period 01 April 2004 and 31 March 2011. For this exercise windfall developments are defined as those sites of less than 4 dwellings that would not have been allocated due to size. The main results are:


- 509 planning applications were for sites of less than 4 dwellings, which would not have been allocated. This equates to 86.4% of applications
- 671 dwellings were approved on sites of less than 4 dwellings, which would not have been allocated. This equates to 38.7% of all dwellings approved.
- 189 dwellings were completed on single plots. This equates to 17.3% of all dwellings completed in this period.


These results do not include the larger windfall sites at Colburn.


